

10 Questions to Ask Before Hiring an Estate Planning Lawyer

- 5. Are all of your fees flat? What about for ongoing work after the initial completion of my estate plan documents? What happens when I call with legal questions after my planning documents were completed? What if the questions are about something other than my estate plan?
- 6. Can you assist me with both simple and advanced estate planning? Can you help me evaluate tools to minimize my estate taxation and protect the wealth for which I have worked so hard?
- 7. Do you make sure my assets are titled in the right way? How?
- 8. Can you structure my estate plan so that whatever I leave to my kids will be protected from a lawsuit against them or if they are divorced in the future? How often do you build that kind of planning into clients' plans?
- 9. Do you prepare a comprehensive plan for my kids' care if something happens to me that names short and long-term guardians and gives specific instructions to all of the guardians and my caregivers? What about an ID card for my wallet listing the short-term guardians with their contact information?
- 10. Do you have a whole team in place or is it just you? What happens if something happens to you or you retire? What happens if I need to get a quick question answered and you are not available?
