

## **Common Estate Planning Mistakes**

- 1. Property not placed in living trust.
- 2. Deficient will or trust prepared by non-Florida attorney.
- 3. Belief that the estate tax has been repealed.
- 4. Belief that living trusts avoid estate taxes.
- 5. Undoing estate plan with joint property.
- 6. No provision in your living trust for your long term care in the event of your disability.
- 7. Individual retirement accounts, annuity benefits and life insurance proceeds passing to the wrong beneficiaries.
- 8. Not having health care powers of attorney and living wills for every state in which you reside.
- 9. Deficient financial power of attorney.
- 10. Life insurance owned by the wrong person.
- 11. Disinheriting spouse inadvertently using a family trust.
- 12. Disinheriting grandchildren inadvertently.
- 13. Not taking advantage of annual gift tax exclusion.
- 14. Leaving inheritance outright to children who cannot manage finances or have marital or creditor problems.
- 15. Choosing the wrong successor trustee.
